
There has been one design on our drawing board that we have all been very keen to see come to life. Sunshine Cove's North Park, our community's own adventure playground. Destined to become a signature feature within our community, it occupies one of the most prized pieces of real estate on the north facing shoreline of our lake linking the Trinity and Brighton Precinct walkways and boardwalks.

Under the watchful gaze of our landscape architects, Place Design Group, North Park's one hectare site has unfolded with all sorts of leisure features that include a natural, grassed amphitheater and direct access to the lake via a boat ramp and wharf for those wishing to take advantage of our lake. Currently water quality of the lake has been excellent with such exceptional clarity our keen fishermen have been able to see the size of the passing schools of

fish they have been seeking.

The centre piece of course is the Adventure Playground for our younger community members. As you can see there from the above design, lots of physical activity hubs have been planned to keep the kids amused whilst they soak up a little vitamin D.

"We have always spoken of our desire to build a community rather than develop land, North Park is yet another layer in the foundations established at the design stage. Having such a large green space available will encourage the sense of community we seek. Our team is over the moon with the result and can't wait for its opening in time for Christmas." Said Development Manager, Evan Dickson.





DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

A great run of good weather has seen our development programme achieve significant advances in the works within our latest residential precinct of Trinity.

Taking advantage of our clear skies has also enabled work to begin on Mackenzie, our first residential precinct to be located on the southern side of the lake. Besides completion of the bulk earthworks, Mackenzie calls for some significant infrastructure development such as the construction of our first vehicular bridge across the lake. Once complete this link will enable development of the first 70 residential allotment release with Mackenzie.

Civil works have also commenced within the mixed use, residential and commercial precinct of Flinders. Completion of the Flinders Lane service road will enable the first of the Flinders allotments to be released fronting Maroochy Boulevard.

As you can see from the image above, our landscaping work continues as a priority as we progress development along the parklands adjacent to Sunshine Cove Way.

If you have seen what we have achieved recently, you really should take a stroll out along the lake front. It's beautiful.



Whilst we saw Sunshine Cove as much a move in lifestyle terms, it was also a lifestyle solution. With our children grown up and neither of us having that much interest in gardens and maintenance, we wanted a maintenance free home life. The building allotment though smaller than what we have been used to has given us the opportunity to design a home with the room and space of a family home without having to have a huge backyard to take care of. Yet if we feel the urge to roll in the grass we have acres of it just a short walk along the boardwalk. Brilliant really.
