Construction update

The next few months are set to be busy in terms of civil construction at Sunshine Cove with the developers about to embark on numerous construction stages and areas. First to commence will be the removal of a staggering 45,000 cubic metres of preloard, top soil and fill from the end of the peninsula which will take approximately 6 to 8 weeks. Concurrently with those works will be the civil construction and development of the first stage of the Savannah Precinct to deliver 28 new lots to the community. These works will also require the road, drainage, electrical installation, service installation and streetscape for the continuation of Sunshine Cove Way to the Savannah Precinct. Finally the team will be landscaping and finalising our newest parklands to the land between Sunshine Cove and the lake at the end of Amity Avenue, complete with an observation deck providing yet another great location to sit and contemplate life from!
